A Provençal-style rosé with an added English twist. Traditional rosé flavours of strawberry and raspberry combine with fresh acidity and a lovely herby finish.

Created from grape varieties fermented separately and blended to create a silky smooth rosé.

Pinot Noir, Meunier and Regent provide lovely soft fruit character, whilst Bacchus and Chardonnay give freshness and aromatic quality maintained by cool fermentation at low temperatures.

Nannette's Rose takes the best elements of pale rosés, adds softness and complexity to create an intriguing wine that is perfect for the English summer sunshine.

Region: Weald, Kent, South East England.

Vineyard: Multi-site

TASTING NOTES

Appearance: Delicate, pale Provençal pink.

Nose: A herby and aromatic nose, with strawberry and red berry fruit carried through to the palate.

Palate: Crisp, light, hints of lemon, thyme and rosemary.

Excellent with green salads, fresh seafood and soft or blue cheeses.
